Ronald McDonald House: Pittsburgh Door Décor

Bring smiles to the families' faces by decorating the doors on one of the residence floors. Decorations may be holiday and/or seasonally-themed. Schedule to door decorate in late March for Spring, late May for Summer, mid-September for Fall, and mid-November for winter. You may sign up to decorate the doors on a floor, or you can drop off the decorations curbside and one of the staff members will hang the decoration on your group's behalf.



Ronald McDonald House: Pittsburgh Door Décor events can take place 7 days a week 9 am to 8 pm.



After scheduling a date to volunteer in person, an event confirmation form must be filled out & emailed, mailed, or faxed to the Volunteer & Outreach Coordinator within four business days.



Only Ronald McDonald House: Pittsburgh apartment doors may be decorated in the residence halls.



Doors are magnetic. Please provide magnets to adhere décor to the doors. Please do not use tape or sticky tack. Please consider the weight of your décor, as heavy items tend to fall off of doors.



Ronald McDonald House: Pittsburgh apartment door sizes are 36 in. x 80 in. There are 10 doors per floor.



No religious themes may be used.



Please notify the Volunteer & Outreach Coordinator if you plan to donate décor to Ronald McDonald House: Pittsburgh or schedule a time to pick items up after the season. (we cannot store decorations)



Due to the size of the floors and the families' compromised immune systems, please limit your group to no more than 6 individuals. Volunteers must be 13 years of age or older. Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.



All persons volunteering at Ronald McDonald House: Pittsburgh must sign a volunteer release form at time of arrival.



Individuals should use appropriate hygiene practices and be free of any signs of illness. If recently exposed to COVID-19, please stay home.

For any Ronald McDonald House: Pittsburgh families that you may come in contact with, please keep in mind that the guests are presently experiencing crises in their lives. It is important to be empathetic but also consider their need for privacy and space. Please remember to always keep good boundaries with the guests. Entering the family rooms or babysitting Ronald McDonald House: Pittsburgh children is not permitted.

You are welcome to take photos of your group while at the House; however, no children or family members may be in the picture. Please contact Nya if you intend to have any media cover your event.

These decorations and themes promote a caring and uplifting environment for the families during a difficult time.
