Volunteer Parking

- Take 44th street, turn into the driveway to the Mid Campus Garage. If you cannot access the garage from 44th street, loop around the block to the 45th street entrance. Be sure to walk towards 44th street exit.
- To the right up the driveway, you will see a Ronald McDonald statue sitting on a bench. Enter the front door & hit the call box button. Tell the attendant that you are here to volunteer.
- Take the elevators up to the Penthouse Floor (PH).
- Please do not park on the street in front of the main entrance. You may be issued a ticket.
- If you choose to park in the neighborhood nearby the Charity, please notice the permitted parking signs.

Pay Stations

When you leave Ronald McDonald House: Pittsburgh, pay stations are conveniently located to your right (glass doors) at the entrance to the Transformation Corridor in the Mid-Campus Garage.

In-Kind Donation Drop-Off & Unloading

- For the protection of the immunocompromised families, we are only able to accept brand-new items.
- Drop-off hours are 7 days a week. We ask that large drop-offs be pre-scheduled M-F before 7 pm.
- Please call the front office/Guest Relations team when you are on your way. This gives the staff a heads-up that you will be arriving (412-246-1105).
- Please see the map to locate the “Drop-Off Zone” in front of Ronald McDonald House: Pittsburgh. To drop off donations, please park temporarily in the fire lane outside of the front door, next to the Ronald McDonald Statue. Next, place your hazard lights/blinkers on. The front door will be locked, please press the call box button & say you are here with a donation. A staff member will be down to greet you with a cart (if needed). Your assistance with loading the cart is appreciated. *Please note that we are operating with a small staff. We thank you for your patience as there may be unloading delays.
- We request that you please fill out a donation drop off form upon arrival, so we can properly acknowledge your/your group’s kindness & generosity.
- Donation drop-offs will be curbside due to families’ compromised immune systems. Please come prepared to drop off your donations outside, unless the staff requests your support. If your support is requested inside the building, please make sure you are healthy, without any visible signs of illness.
- Drop-Off Zone is for unloading only. Parking longer than 10 minutes may result in a ticket.
